Page 47	<p>Answer 10 and its explanation should read:</p> <p>The correct answer is (D).</p> <p>An isosceles triangle is made up of at least two equal sides. While the third side also can be equal (i.e., equilateral triangle), the side lengths are unknown in Column A. Therefore, the relationship cannot be determined from the information given.</p>
